

## Domestic Field Trips College of Liberal Arts

### What is a domestic field trip?

A domestic field trip is a form of faculty-led student travel, taking place off-campus and within the United States. While there is no requirement a field trip be credit-bearing, in the College of Liberal Arts these trips are often a required or optional component of a credit-bearing, campus-based course. In such case, less than 50 percent of the course may be conducted during the trip.

### What is the approval process and deadline?

1. Prepare a typed [Request and Approval for a Field Trip with or without a Fee](#).
2. Attach the following:
  - basic budget, to show how the fee (if requesting) was determined
  - tentative itinerary
3. After obtaining departmental approval, submit to Christie Dunn in Coke 204A by the following deadline (deadlines apply if requesting a fee):

- May/Summer	March 1
- Fall	June 1
- Winter/Spring	September 1
